Primary 6 Civic District Trail Learning Journey

Dear Parent / Guardian

The Primary 6 pupils will be going on a learning journey to the different heritage zones in the Southern part of Singapore on **7 January 2015 from 8.30 a.m. to 12.30 p.m.** The pupils will be visiting Raffles Landing Site, Singapore River, Cavenagh Bridge, Parliament House and The Cenotaph. The learning theme of 'Politicians' for the Primary Six level is infused into the learning journey. This learning journey also aims to bond the pupils together as a class. The purpose of the learning journey is:

1. To be exposed to the history of Singapore
2. To develop the understanding of contributions of politicians in the past and present in Singapore and other ASEAN countries.
3. To understand how politicians have built Singapore to what she is now
4. To identify the positive values the politicians exhibit and apply these values and skills into their daily life
5. To develop and share with their peers their individualised action plans to realise their personal goals in relation to politicians.
6. To display discipline, teamwork and self-motivation while carrying out activities

The visit to the Civic District Trail is a recap of Singapore's history. It is to allow the pupils to gain awareness of the rich cultural heritage and appreciate the legacies of which continue to influence our lives now. This is an extension of the learning from the textbook to the experiential component. Pupils will thus learn the importance of how Singapore has prospered since the days of the early immigrants to become a prosperous, harmonious and multicultural country. Pupils will be using iPad during the trail to internalize the learning outcomes and also to infuse teamwork and team bonding among pupils. They will be expected to complete a reflection on what they have learned during their learning journey.

Pupils are expected to have their breakfast before coming to school as they will be setting off on the learning journey at 8.30 a.m. Please ensure that your child brings sufficient pocket money on that day. Pupils are to bring a small bag with the necessary items.
