Open and authentic relationships






- Use of Expenditure Card to record purchase of food and its price

- ✓ Water bottle










- 10-minute Snack Break

All personal items should be labelled with your child's / ward's full name and class.




Tiered System of Support (TSS)






Tiered System of Support (TSS)


