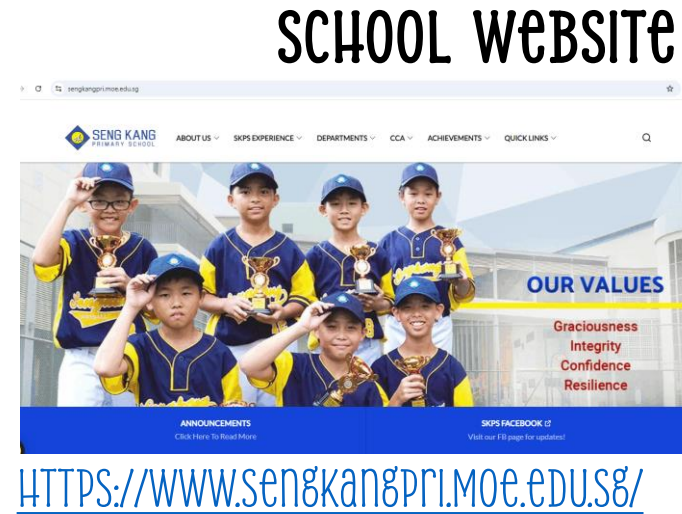

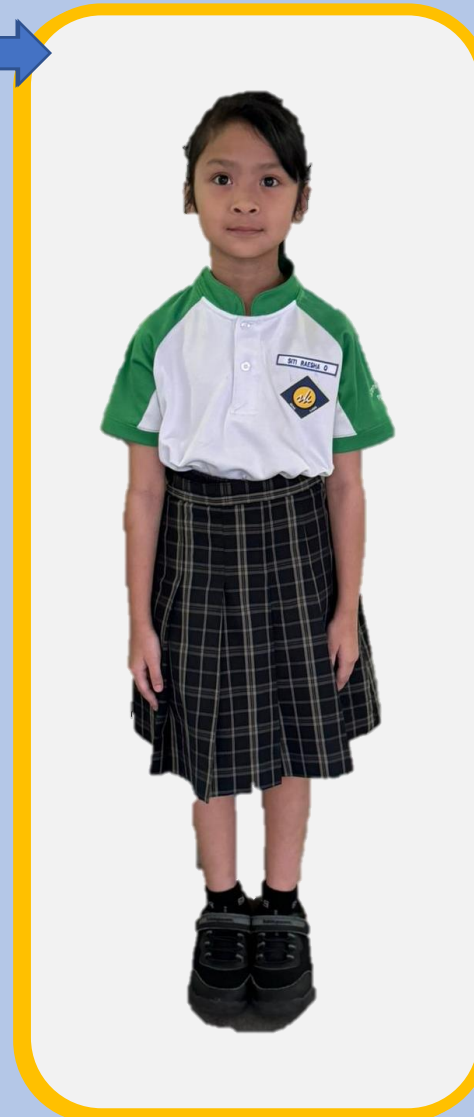

P1 students can enter school via Gate 3A (back gate) from 3 January onwards.

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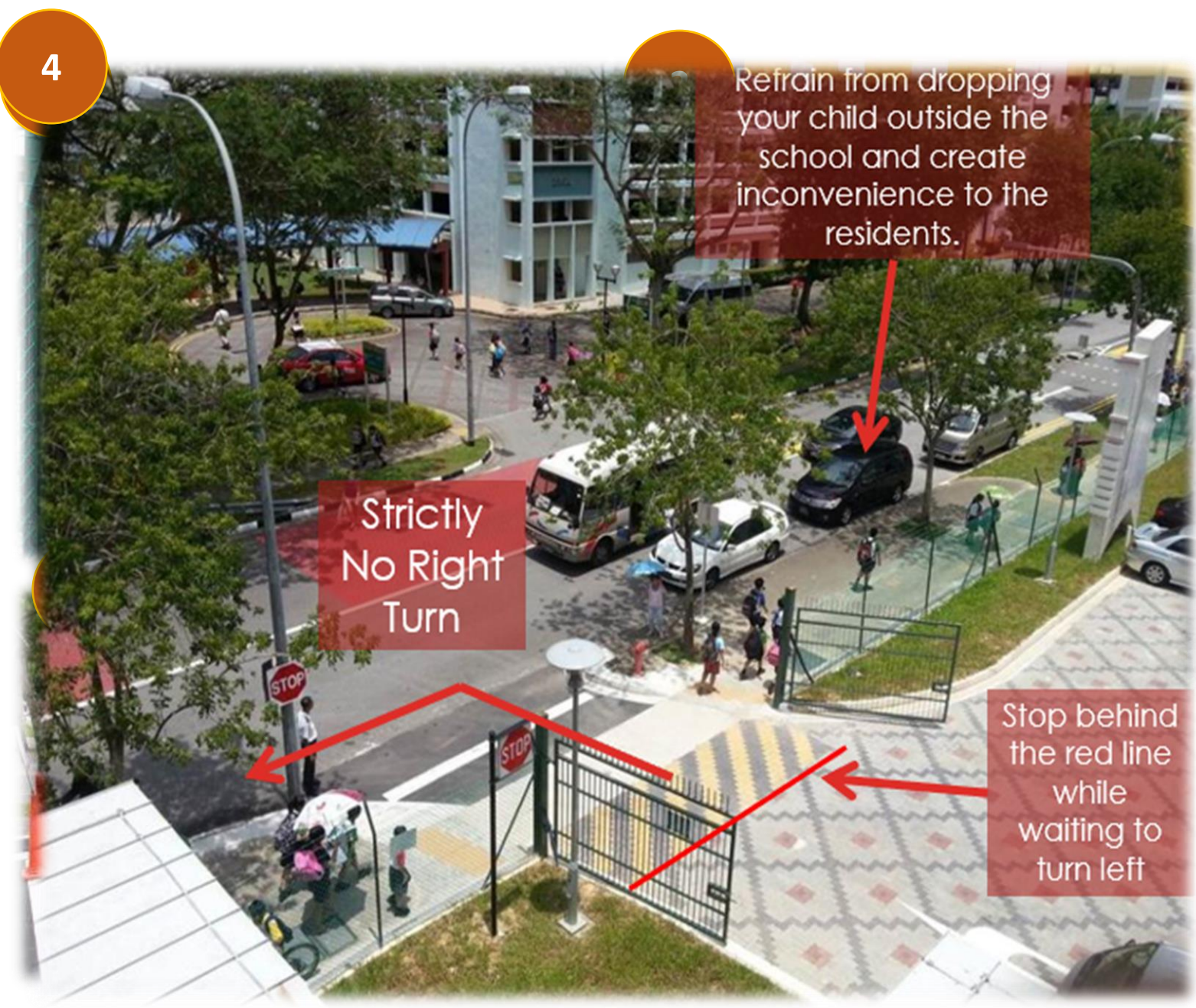

## (a) Students picked up by parents or caregivers

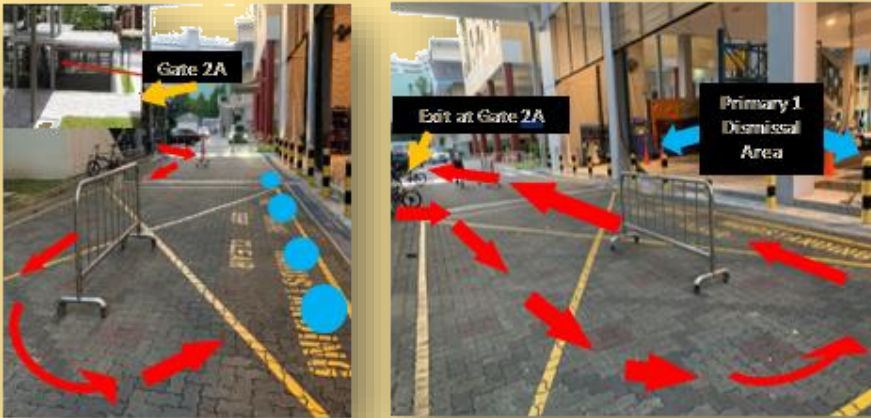
Please pick up your child/ward **ONLY** at the **basketball court** and exit via **Gate 2A**. If parents/caregivers are late, the child will wait at the General Office.

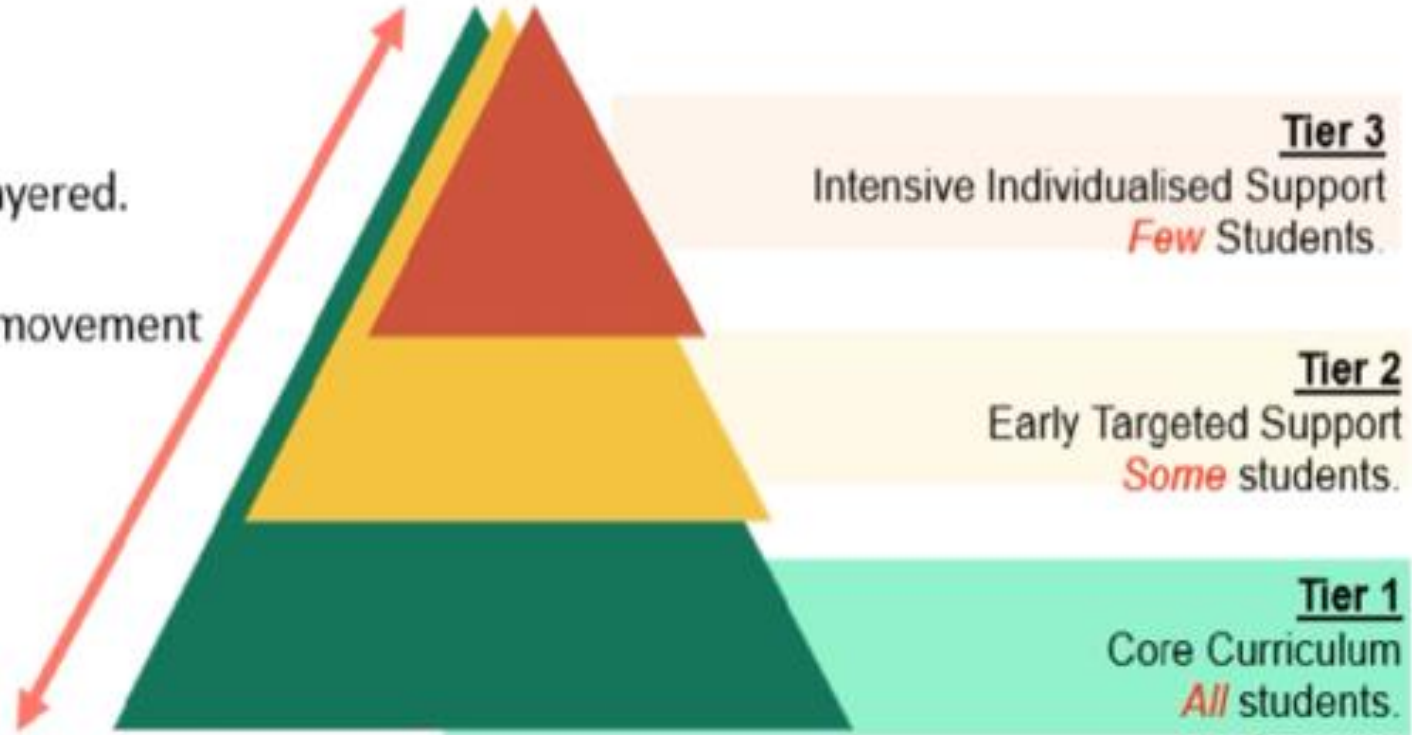

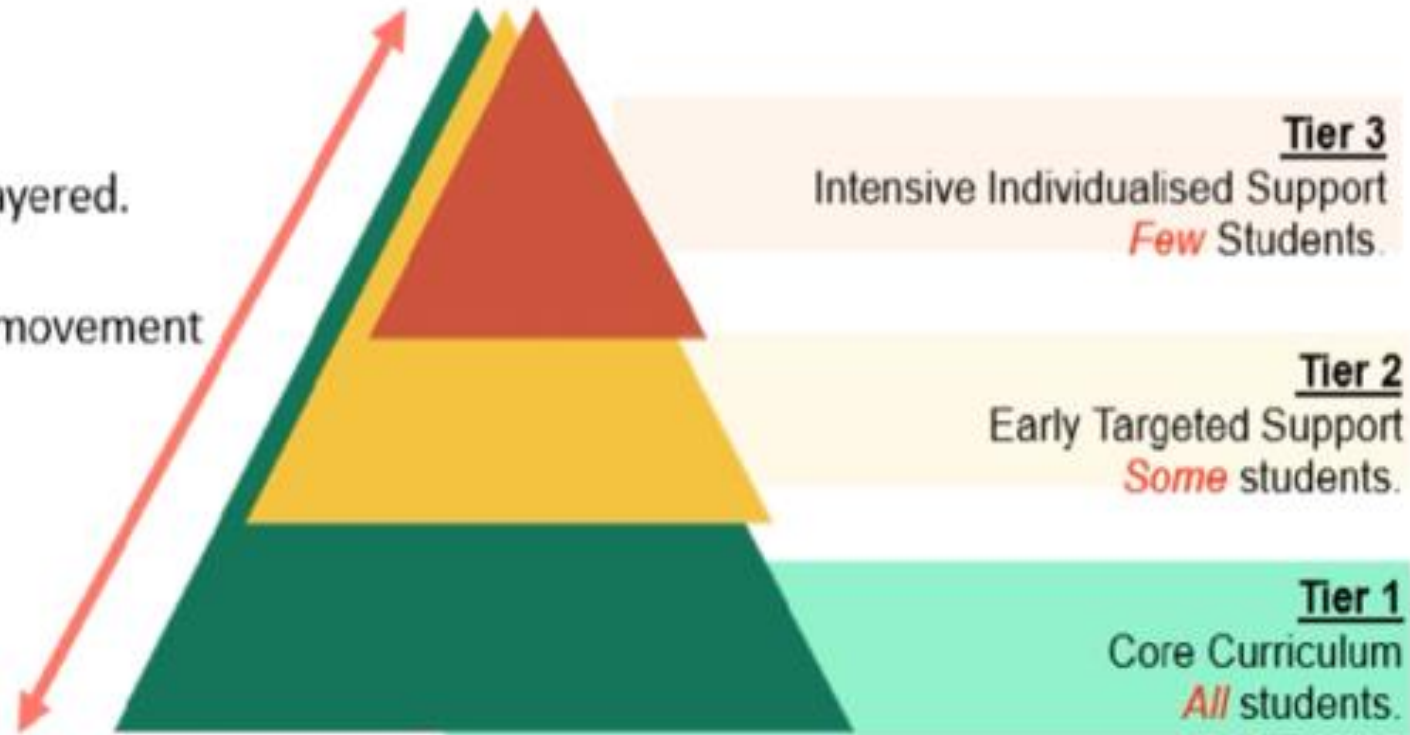

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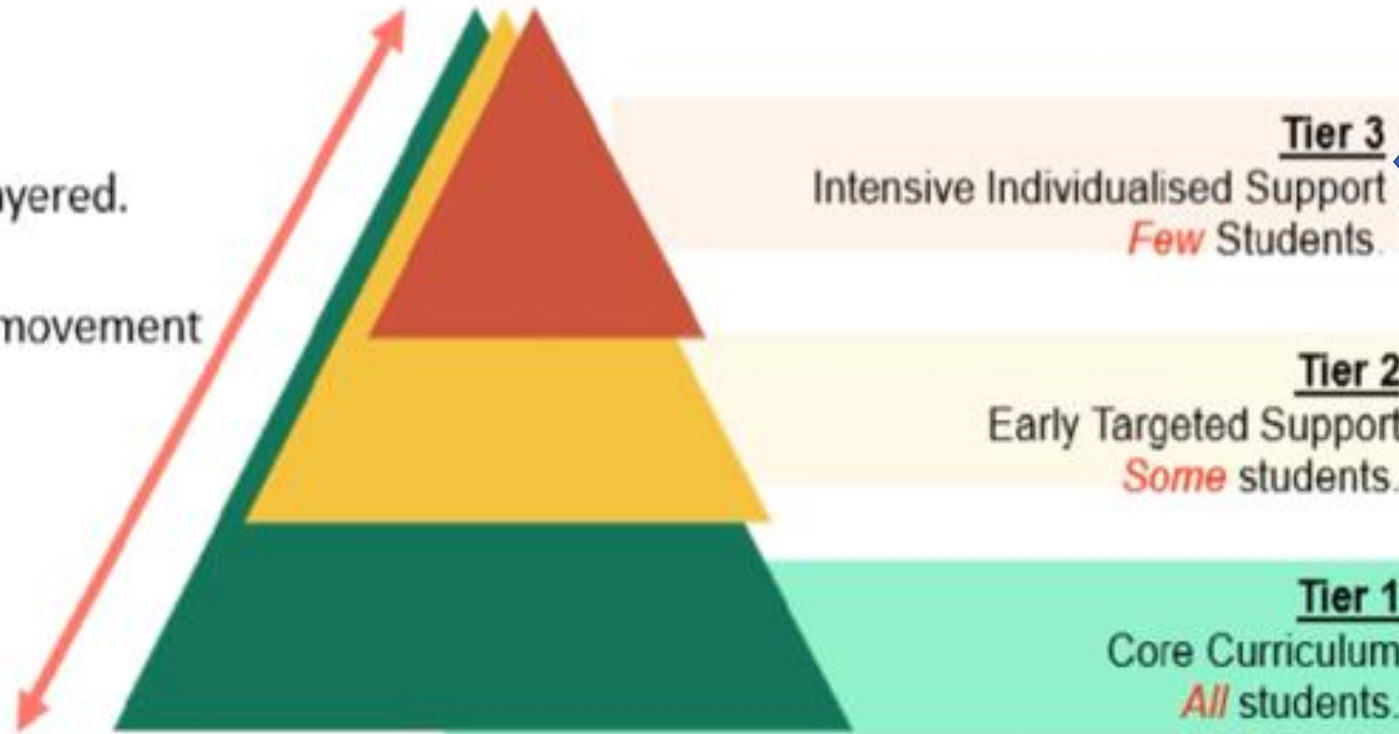
