Update on Measures for School Arrival and Use of Face Shields

We thank you for your support, cooperation and suggestions on how we can continue to keep our children safe in school.

As we enter into the second half of Phase 1 after the Circuit Breaker period and after familiarising all students with the safe distancing measures through our back-to-school orientation programme, we would like to inform you that we will be opening **Gate 3A (Back Gate)** in the morning with effect from **Monday, 15 June** so as to further ease the traffic flow for school arrival. Students entering through both gates will be guided to walk through the thermal scanners and screened to ensure that they do not have flu-like symptoms.

We seek parents' continued support and co-operation to observe safe distancing measures at the school gates to minimise overcrowding and congestion for the safety of everyone. Parents driving can continue to alight your child/children at the bus bay. However, we seek your assistance to remind your child/children to observe safety when alighting from the vehicle.

Our children have been issued with a face shield as an additional protection to their face mask. Please ensure that your children bring along their face shield every day so that they can use it during recess as they consume their meal. The Primary 4 and 5 students will be issued with face shield when they return to school next week. As announced by MOH on 2 June, the face mask is the default form of protection against virus transmission so all students and staff are expected to don a face mask in school.
