Dear Parents/Guardians,

By now, you would have received the information from the press and from MOE's notification through Parents Gateway, that MOE will progressively bring students back to school after the June holidays. Primary 1 to 3 students will be on **Home-Based Learning (HBL) for the first week of Term 3 (28 June to 2 July 2021)**. They will return to school from **Tuesday, 6 July 2021** onwards. (Monday, 5 July 2021, is a school holiday).

During the HBL phase, we will provide instructions and support for your child to access a range of both online and hardcopy HBL materials, so that learning continues uninterrupted. **The work for each day would be posted on the Singapore Student Learning Space (SLS) platform**, which your child is familiar with.

Schedule for 28 June to 2 July 2021

The details of the daily schedule will be posted on SLS:

(a) Daily Check-in/Check-out

There will be a daily **synchronous** check-in or check-out through SLS for your child to access. It would involve a zoom meeting with your child's Form Teacher to check on your child's well-being.

P1: 0830 to 0845

P2: 0815 to 0830

P3: 0800 to 0815 on Monday and Friday*

We understand that the P1 & P2 may need parental support to access SLS. These check-in sessions are optional as some of you might not be available during the times allocated.

Please advise your child to **access the SLS 15minutes before the stipulated time** so that he/she can be punctual for the sessions.

(b) Synchronous Lessons for P3 (live lessons conducted through zoom or through interactive live lessons on SLS)

There will be one hour of synchronous lesson on one subject (English, Mathematics or Science) for P3 students every morning from 0800 to 0900 during the week of 28 Jun to 2 July. One hour of synchronous Mother Tongue lesson will be conducted from 1230 to 1330 on 30 June (Wednesday).

*The lessons for Monday and Friday will be held immediately after the Check-In sessions.

(c) Asynchronous Lessons (offline lessons assigned through SLS)

In addition to the synchronous lessons, P3 students will be assigned asynchronous work based on their current timetable. P1 & P2 students' work will also be asynchronous based on their current timetable. Students can take their time to complete the work during the course of the day.
