Dear Parents/ Guardians,

Extension of School Meal Subsidies during Full Home-Based Learning

Students under Financial Assistance Schemes (FAS) will receive meal subsidies regardless of whether they return to school during the full home-based learning (HBL) period. The provision will cover the four weeks of HBL from 8 April to 4 May 2020.

The school meal subsidies will be disbursed via two top-ups to eligible students' School Smartcard, and you can redeem at any TransitLink Add Value Machine once every two weeks starting from Tuesday, 14 April. The disbursement will not be done via PayNow or bank transfer. FAS students in primary schools will receive \$80 each while students in secondary schools and junior colleges will receive \$120.

The School Smartcard can be used to purchase food and essential groceries at some hawker centres, food courts, minimarts, convenience stores and supermarkets. The links are as follows:
